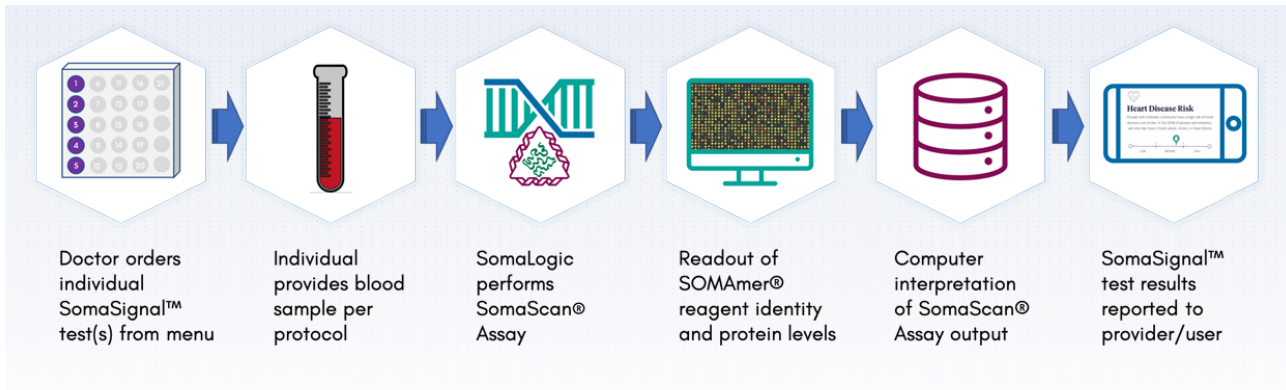

Medical Definition of *soma*: the body of an organism

The SomaScan® **Assay** refers to SomaLogic’s laboratory-based measurement of proteins.

The SomaScan® **Platform** encompasses all the SomaLogic technology – sample handling to assay to analysis to result generation – that underlies our individual disease/condition test offerings (see SomaSignal™ tests, below).

[SomaSignal™ test](#)

A SomaSignal™ test is an information-generating health test for a specific disease/condition (e.g., primary cardiovascular risk). A SomaSignal™ test is ordered off the menu by a doctor. The menu includes all such tests offered to the market (i.e., SomaSignal™ tests, not SomaSignals). The information returned to the doctor/user are SomaSignal™ test results.

We have a growing menu of such “body signal” or SomaSignal™ tests, from repeated and growing use of the SomaScan® Platform.

Slow Off-rate Modified Aptamer (SOMAmer®) refers to the specific protein-binding reagents that power the SomaScan® Assay.
